Extended Descriptions

- 1 pF arcuate L Reminds of the Veil. I could see the full extent as shown in the Real Sky. The west end is narrow and the east end spreads out. The best views were with the 31 N and an OIII. The 41 Pan was also good. UHC showed the object, but not as well. Steady with direct vision, brighter averted See Jul - Aug 2009 newsletter for observing article.
- 2 S pF E Could be seen in the 12N as well as a small diffuse elongated smudge of haze. The UHC improved contrast, but did not increase detail. The OIII was not helpful. The visible portion was just the brighter arc of the ring. See January 2010 newsletter for observing article.
